

RESOLUTION NO. 25-1856

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF RED BANK, TENNESSEE, AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO AWARD AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PTARMIGAN PTRAILS FOR THE GODSEY RIDGE TRAIL CONSTRUCTION PROJECT (RFP 25-0901) AND TO AUTHORIZE PROJECT EXPENDITURES TO BE REIMBURSED THROUGH THE PROJECT DIABETES GRANT VIA RESOLUTION NO. 25-1821

WHEREAS, the 2024 City Commission goal is to develop parks, trails, and recreation services, and the 2025 City Commission goal is to implement the Parks and Recreation Master Plan, ensuring long-term planning and development of the City's recreational resources; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Master Plan identified the development of the Godsey Ridge Trail System as a priority project to expand recreational opportunities, improve connectivity, and support healthy active living within the community; and

WHEREAS, the Godsey Ridge Trail System is funded through the Project Diabetes Grant, authorized via Resolution No. 25-1821, from the State of Tennessee, which reimburses eligible expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the City of Red Bank publicly advertised and released a Request for Proposals (RFP 25-0901) seeking qualified contractors for the construction of the Godsey Ridge Trail System located at 3620 Tom Weathers Drive; and

WHEREAS, the City received four (4) proposals during the open solicitation period, of which three (3) were complete and responsive to the RFP requirements; and

WHEREAS, the proposals were reviewed and evaluated by City staff and the Parks & Recreation Citizens' Advisory Board in accordance with the published criteria, and Ptarmigan Ptrails was determined to be the most qualified.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the City of Red Bank does hereby award the bid for the Godsey Ridge Trail Construction Project (RFP 25-0901) to Ptarmigan Ptrails for the construction of the Godsey Ridge Trail System for a total amount not to exceed \$136,000.00, reimbursable through the Project Diabetes Grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby authorized to sign and enter into a contract on behalf of the City with Ptarmigan Ptrails, upon approval of the contract by the City Attorney, and to take all actions necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution, including authorizing expenditures to be reimbursed through the Project Diabetes Grant.
